The Upper Shore Regional Council (USRC), an economic development and planning agency for Cecil, Kent, and Queen Anne's Counties, will be hosting a Council meeting on Thursday, March 29, 2012 at 1:30 p.m. The Executive Board is comprised of County Commissioners from the three counties and the Council's Executive Director, Doris S. Mason. The Board includes, William Pickrum, Chair, representing Kent County, Steven J. Arentz, 1st Vice Chair, of Queen Anne's County, and Diana Broomell, 2nd Vice Chair of Cecil County. The Secretary and Treasurer are David L. Dunmyer of Queen Anne's County and Alexander P. Rasin of Kent County, respectively. Senator E.J. Pipkin represents the General Assembly on the Board of Directors. The meetings, which are held quarterly, may be conducted in either of the three partner counties with this meeting being held at in Millington, MD, at the Two Tree Restaurant.

The Council consists of State Senators and Delegates representing the region, County Commissioners of the three Counties, Municipal Representatives of the individual Counties, and the County Administrators. The Council will meet again in June, September and December, rotating the location throughout the three counties. Additionally, members from partner agencies across the region, including Economic Development and Tourism Directors, Chamber of Commerce Presidents, and others who participate on the Council's standing committees will be invited to attend. Partners and members from the various businesses and services delivery sectors from the region will also be invited to the meeting. Either of the above groups may be represented on the agenda. Finally, the Council's Executive Director presents an update on the Council's current major projects.
