The Upper Shore Regional Council (USRC), an economic development and planning agency for Cecil, Kent, and Queen Anne's Counties, will be hosting an Executive Board meeting on Thursday, May 24, 2012 at 1:30 p.m. The Executive Board is comprised of County Commissioners from the three. The Board includes, William Pickrum, Chair, representing Kent County, Steven J. Arentz, 1st Vice Chair (Queen Anne's County) and Diana Broomell, Vice Chair (Cecil County), David L. Dunmyer, Secretary, (Queen Anne's County). Senator E.J. Pipkin represents the General Assembly on the Board of Directors for the region.

The Executive Board meetings, which are held twice per quarter, may be conducted in either of the three partner counties, and they are tele-conferenced. Plans are being made for the May 24, 2012, meeting to be teleconferenced from the USRC's headquarters at 122 N. Cross Street, Chestertown, MD. Meetings are open to the public.

The full USRC Council, which meets quarterly, will meet again on June 21, 2012 at 1:30 p.m. (location TBD). The Council, consisting of members of the General Assembly, Commissioners of the three counties, County Administrators and Municipal Representatives will also meet in September and December, 2012, rotating the location throughout the three counties. Attendees from partner agencies, businesses, Economic Development and Tourism Directors, County Planning and Zoning Officials, County IT/Technology Directors and others from the region are also a part of the agenda.

Additionally, the Council's Executive Director, Doris S. Mason, presents an update on the Council's current major projects. All meetings are open to the general public.
