The Upper Shore Regional Council (USRC), an economic development and planning agency for Cecil, Kent, and Queen Anne's Counties, will be hosting an Executive Board meeting on Thursday, July 26, 2012 at 1:30 p.m. The Executive Board meetings are typically attended comprised of County Commissioners from the three counties and the Council's Executive Director, Doris S. Mason. The Board includes, William Pickrum, Chair, representing Kent County, Steven J. Arentz, 1st Vice Chair representing Queen Anne's County, and Diana Broomell, 2nd Vice Chair of Cecil County, David L. Dunmyer, Secretary of Queen Anne's County, Jim Mullin, Treasurer of Cecil County, and representing the General Assembly for the region is Senator E.J. Pipkin. The Executive Board meetings, which are held twice per quarter, may be conducted in either of the three partner counties, and they are teleconferenced. The July 26, 2012, meeting will be teleconferenced from the USRC's headquarters at 122 N. Cross Street, Chestertown, MD.

The Council will hold it's August Executive Board meeting at the Maryland Association of Counties (MACO) Annual Summer Conference in Ocean City, Maryland on August 17, 2012 at noon.

The full USRC Council, which meets quarterly, will meet again on September 27, 2012 at 1:30 p.m. in Cecil County, MD. The Council, consisting of members of the General Assembly, Commissioners of the three counties, County Administrators and Municipal Representatives will also meet in December, 2012, rotating the location throughout the three counties. Attendees from partner agencies, businesses, Economic Development and Tourism Directors, County Planning and Zoning Officials, County IT/Technology Directors and others from the region are typically a part of the agenda.

Additionally, the Council's Executive Director, Doris S. Mason, presents an update on the Council's current major projects. All meetings are open to the general public.
